## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Crystal Clear Special Utility District has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened and what we are doing (or did) to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the compliance period of January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2015, we did not test for Lead & Copper and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

The table below lists the contaminants we did not properly test for during the sampling period, how often we are supposed to sample for Lead & Copper, how many samples we are supposed to take, how many we took, when samples should have been taken and the date on which the follow up samples should have been taken.
