
Meters in the district:



Majority of the meters will flash different codes that look like these:

Info codes:

• Flow: water is flowing through meter

• Leak: small leak detected

• Burst: bad leak detected

• Dry: meter has no water in it

Tamper: meter has been physically abused

• Reverse: flow of water reversed

If the first 4 numbers of your meter start with 1008.... Your warning icons will look like this:

Info code flashes in the display	Meaning
Flow	The three segments will switch on alternately to indicate flow in the meter
Backflow	Indication if there is reverse flow
Leak	The water has not been stagnant in the meter during the past 24 hours. This can be a sign of a leaky faucet or toilet.
Burst	The water flow has exceeded a preprogrammed limit for a minimum of 30 minutes, which is a sign of a burst pipe.
Dry	The meter is not water-filled.
Tamper	Attempt of fraud. The meter is no longer valid for billing purposes.
Radio OFF ((•)) OFF	The meter is still in transport mode with the built-in radio transmitter turned off. The transmitter turns on automatically when the frst 1/4 gallon of water has run though the meter.
Flow unit	Indicates the configured flow unit.
Battery	Indication of the battery state.
Active meter indication	A small square is flashing to indicate that the meter is active.
Meter adjustment AB	If the meter has been dismounted, tested and the basic flow measurement has been adjusted this info code will appear.
