**Ways to Conserve water and Grow a beautiful garden**

1. Recycle water.
2. Layer mulch to conserve moisture, reduce weeds and soil disease
3. Plant perennials instead of annuals when deciding what flowers to plant. Perennials have deeper root and require less water.
4. Water wisely- most landscape flowers don't need to be watered everyday, but they should be watered early morning or at night.
5. Rely on rainfall
6. Collect rain- Place a water barrel beneath the downspouts of the house to collect rain water. Use the rainwater
7. Lastly, if your plant is looking wilted on a hot summer day, that may be normal. However if the plant looks wilted in the morning, water right away!



**Lawn Irrigation and Swimming Season Signals Time to Check Backflow Preventers**

As the summer season approaches and people fill swimming pools and activate lawn sprinklers, there are some important things to know and do to protect our public drinking water.



**Backflow preventers** keep contaminants from infiltrating the public water system by stopping the reverse flow of non-drinkable water into drinkable water pipes.



Be sure to call 811 before you dig so that all lines can be marked.

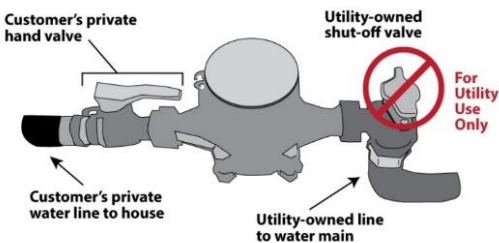


**Feasibility/ Engineer Study**

If you are in the market to purchase property or add a building of any sort to a currently owned property, which water will be associated, it is strongly recommended that you contact CCSUD prior. Many people assume properties have those utility services in place; we have seen cases where the new land owner is shocked to find out that no water services exist.

CCSUD uses a third-party engineering firm that tracks any information about line sizes, line capacity, etc. Please be aware that we do not have that information here in our office. CCSUD has to send any inquiries, Engineer or Feasibility studies, to ensure adequate and correct information is given.

Reach out to any of our CSRs and they can advise you of pricing and the proper steps to take to complete a Feasibility/ Engineer Study.

**DID YOU KNOW?**

- Advancements in safe and clean water are considered one of the greatest accomplishments of the 20th Century.
- The EPA regulates drinking water quality.
- The EPA does not regulate private wells (but some states do!).
- There are over 150,000 public water systems in the USA, alone.
- Drinking a glass of water as you start your day can jump start your energy and metabolism for the first 2 to 3 hours of your day.
- While the human body may be over 70% water, the human brain is approximately 80%, and a tomato is about 95% water!
- Water covers about 70% of the earth, and approximately 96% of that is salt water.



Sprinkler or irrigation systems may water two days per week BEFORE 10 a.m. and AFTER 8 p.m.

Based on the last digit of the address:  
**Even numbers (0,2,4,6,8)** – Watering days are Monday and Thursday.

**Odd numbers (1,3,5,7,9)** – Watering days are Tuesday and Friday.

If conditions persist, it may be necessary to move to Stage 2 Water Restrictions.
