



Director Candidate Acknowledgement and Attestation Agreement

Texas law sets forth specific qualifications for serving on the Board of Directors of Crystal Clear Special Utility District (the District).¹ By signing this document, you acknowledge that you are aware of and meet these legal qualifications to serve on the District's Board of Directors.

By signing this document, I agree that each of the following are true statements:

- I am at least 18 years of age.
- I am a resident of the State of Texas.
- I either own land subject to taxation in the District, am a user of the facilities of the District, or am a qualified voter of the District.
- I am not related within the third degree of affinity or consanguinity to a developer of property in the District, any other member of the board, or the manager, engineer, attorney, or other person providing professional services to the district.
- I am not an employee of any developer of property in the District or any director, manager, engineer, attorney, or other person providing professional services to the District or a developer of property in the District in connection with the District or property located in the District.
- I am not a developer of property in the district.
- I am not serving as an attorney, consultant, engineer, manager, architect, or in some other professional capacity for the district or a developer of property in the district in connection with the district or property located in the district.
- I am not a party to a contract with or along with the District except for the purchase of public services furnished by the District to the public generally.
- I am not a party to a contract with or along with a developer of property in the District relating to the District or to property within the District, other than a contract limited solely to the purpose of purchasing or conveying real property in the District for the purpose of either establishing a permanent residence, establishing a commercial business within the District, or qualifying as a director.

Additionally, I acknowledge the following provisions of Texas law:

- If I fail to maintain the qualifications required by law to serve as a director during my term of office, I will be disqualified from the District Board of Directors.
- If I willfully occupy an office as a member of a board and exercise the powers and duties of that office when disqualified under the provisions above, then I am guilty of a misdemeanor.
